Our volunteer program is available to individuals seeking school related volunteer hours, as well as those who just want to make a difference in the life of an animal.

ABOUT OUR ON SITE VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

The Volunteer program is for individuals 16 years of age and up who are willing to make a commitment. Due to insurance liability requirements, we cannot approve volunteers under the age of 16 without adult supervision. Anyone under 16 has to have a parent or adult guardian present at all times.

HOW TO GET STARTED

Please complete the Volunteer Application and submit it to the SPCA. You will be contacted via email with upcoming shelter orientation dates. Volunteer Orientations are a vital component of understanding how shelter operations flow. Orientation will include a tour of the facility, overview of our operations, and a question and answer session.

VOLUNTEER JOBS AVAILABLE

Cat Companion

Socializing with the cats in our care is important for their health, wellness, and adoptability. Volunteers play with, pet, and groom our cats, helping them get comfortable with human interactions.

Shelter Helper

Help us meet the needs of daily operations by assisting with laundry, dishes, creating enrichment treats, bathing puppies, and sorting donations.

Kennel Attendant

Assist with the morning or afternoon cleanings within the cattery or dog runs. Shifts for cleaning are available every day from 7:00AM to 11:00AM and then again at 2:30PM until 5:00PM. You are welcome to work an entire shift or just a partial shift.

Adoption Event Assistant

This role primarily involves providing assistance during events, including setup and breakdown of materials. Volunteers are needed to assist with handling canines on leash as well as caring for the cats in crate set-ups. Volunteers under 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.

Public Relations Assistant

Help promote the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA by taking pictures and creating highlight videos or content for our social media channels. This may include assisting with writing newsletters for the SPCA, writing (or learning to write) grant applications, graphic design, marketing animals, office administration tasks, or assisting with volunteer orientations.

Dog Walking and Socialization

Our dogs are full of energy and love to play with their human friends. Volunteers help exercise our dogs throughout the day every day of the week. You must attend a Dog Interaction Orientation which is separate from the basic volunteer orientation and be 18 years of age or older before working with our dogs.

Foster Team

Being a foster parent for a homeless animal is the most rewarding job there is! We are always in need of kind families to open up their home to foster nursing mothers and bottle feeding kittens or puppies. We will send you with all of the supplies you need including food, blankets, bowls, and litter boxes. Sometimes, we receive animals that are too young to be in a shelter environment or medical cases that need more involved care. Fostering is a great way to help us learn more about the animal's behavior so we can find the best fit home for them.

Humane Education Team

Humane Education volunteers assist with our Pet Educational Program. Activities include providing lessons and making presentations to classrooms of various aged children, presenting educational programs to community groups, assisting with marketing and program implementation. Therapy dogs and their owners are encouraged to join this team!

Fido's Finds and Kittie's Kollectibles Thrift Store

Volunteers are needed desperately to assist in our thrift store at 119 E Main Street Martinsville, VA. You will be assigned a shift to assist in the day to day sales, stocking, and maintenance of the store. During basement sales volunteers are always needed to help maintain order, run the register, and answer questions.

Transport Team

There are times when we need to transport our animals to a larger facility or adoption center within the state of Virginia and sometimes further. We need your help! We can provide you with a gas card and will load all of the animals safely into crates inside of your vehicle. You will be given instructions on where to meet the rescue and contact information.

We also need assistance in picking up large donations. If you have a truck and or trailer, you are perfect for this job!

I realize that although the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA has taken measures to protect me, accidents and injuries may still occur. Therefore, I release the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA from any and all claims and causes of action, including but not limited to, negligence or gross negligence, that I or another might have to or arising from any injury or damage that I could sustain while assisting the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA or in connection with my work for the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA.

I fully understand and agree that I am providing my services in a volunteer capacity without any expressed or implied promise of salary or employment benefits. I agree to perform my volunteer duties to the best of my ability and to adhere to agency rules detailed in my orientation. I understand that my volunteer involvement may be terminated for any reason if I do not meet my commitment in an appropriate manner. I agree that the staff of the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA may assign any appropriate task to me. If I feel the task is not appropriate I agree to discuss this with the Volunteer Coordinator.

I agree that the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA may photograph my participation in this program, and hereby release any such photographs to the Martinsville-Henry County SPCA for use in its programs, publications, or other purposes.

I recognize and agree that I am to act responsibly while working with or while in the presence of SPCA animals and staff. This includes but is not limited to striking or verbally abusing animals, staff members, customers, and other volunteers.
